I hope this letter finds you excited to start the new school year. We are getting closer to the start of the school year, and we are ready to begin the work with our students and families. It is our job to make certain each Northwood student is believed in, included, accepted, challenged, safe, and showing growth. First Week of School and Bell Schedule

Our first day of school is Tuesday, August 30th. We do not have school on Friday, September 2nd and Monday, September 5th for the Labor Day holiday. **There will not be a late start on the first Wednesday of school.**

Door Entry on the First Day of School

Students who will be eating breakfast will be entering at 7:35 and all others will be entering at 7:45. If your student is not taking the bus, please account for entrance times in your transportation. On late start days, breakfast will start at 8:15 and students will enter at 8:25. Lunches are no longer provided at no cost this year.

Open House-Thursday August, 25th

We are going to have our Open House for all students and families on Thursday, August 25th in the afternoon. Our goal is for students to get their class schedules, get their Chromebooks (for new students to Northwood), get into their lockers, meet their teachers, and relieve some stress. We also want our parents and students to see our awesome building and meet our staff, as many of our parents have not been inside. This will be a time for a meet and greet with teachers, principals, and parents. Students and parents will also be able to pick up some

information on each of their classes, Fund Run, Athletics, Pay Fees, etc... This will not be time for parent and teacher conferences, so if you wish to have a conference, please contact our counseling center.

(12:00pm-1:45pm) for our incoming 6th graders and any new students to Northwood. (2:15pm-3:45pm) will be for returning students.

This is a "drop-in" event, so come whenever it is convenient for your family during those times.

If Thursday, August 25th does not work for your family, our building will be open on Friday, August 26th and Monday, August 29th from 8:00am to 3:00pm for families. You will not have access to your teachers those days, but you can still get your schedule, tour the building, and get into your locker!

Lockers

We have found that using a padlock is a new concept for many students. We recommend practicing using a padlock prior to this Open House by using a padlock you have at home or this website to practice. Students will be required to use lockers and our school-issued padlock, but practicing on any padlock beforehand has always proven helpful! Locker use will be required.

Nutrition Services

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) waiver that allowed school districts to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students expired at the end of the last school year. This means that for the 2022-23 school year, we are transitioning back to regular prices for school meals, with free/reduced price meals for qualified families.
