COVID 19 Safety Guidelines/Plans

Please know that our primary goal is to keep students and staff safe. For reference, we are basically starting where we left off last year minus attestations. We love having students learning in-person and will adhere to the following guidelines:

- Regardless of vaccination status, masks will be required at all times (except when eating lunch) while inside the building. Students and staff will not be required to wear masks while outside. This includes before entering the building prior to school, during outside PE, and outside after lunch.
- 2. We will maintain 3ft of distance in our classrooms and 6ft of distance in our lunchroom.
- 3. Handwashing will be encouraged multiple times throughout a student's day.

There will be more information regarding our COVID guidelines coming out, but this hits at the important ones at this point.

Due to Covid restrictions, an in person Open House will not take place. A couple items to note:

- 1. Unfortunately, we will <u>not</u> be using lockers to begin the year. We are hoping to use them at some point soon! Each student will be able to use a backpack that they will carry to class with them. We would recommend selecting a backpack with additional padding for a laptop as all students will use school issued Chromebooks for in school and take home use. In addition, please consider storing excess school supplies at home in order to keep the weight of the backpack lower. These lists are intended to fulfill a student's needs for the entire school year.
- 2. It is also a possibility that students will not be using locker rooms for PE or dressing down for PE. But we do know that students will either need to wear or bring tennis shoes every day for their PE class. This would be similar to what students were used to last year.
- 3. If this supply list is a barrier for your family, please reach out to us. We are happy to help.

Student Schedule Pick Up and Tours

- Incoming 6th grade students at Northwood Middle School are invited to get their schedule, new computer, and take a tour of the building on the afternoon of Monday, August 30th from 12:30-3:00. A separate email with specific details and times will be coming out soon!
- 2. 7th and 8th grade students can stop by Northwood to pick up their schedule in front of the school on Thursday, September 2nd and Friday, September 3rd from 7:00-12:00 then again at 1:00 3:00pm. If a student cannot pick up his or her schedule on either of these dates, please know their schedule will be available electronically on PowerSchool around this time and it will be available on the first day of school. We will let you know when schedules are available on PowerSchool!

Breakfast and Lunch

We have been informed that breakfast and lunch will be provided at No Cost again this year. We still need families who qualify to fill out the free and reduced applications. This can help us determine other fees to waive. We will have three lunches in our schedule this year and we will be starting with assigned seating. We hope these restrictions will ease over time.
