We are getting closer to the start of school, which makes us excited to see your kids back in the building everyday. This letter provides information on our 6th grade visit, 7th and 8th grade schedule pick ups, and a few athletic updates. 6th Graders and Students New to Northwood-Drop In Visit

We are excited to welcome all of our 6th grade and NEW 7th & 8th grade students to Northwood on Monday, August 30, at anytime between 12:30-3:00pm. Our staff and leadership students will be hosting the Husky Street Fair where students will be able to pick up their schedules and Chromebooks, meet some of their teachers, pay fees, turn in health forms, register for bus transportation for school and sports, and learn more about Northwood. We will also provide tours of the school so students can get to know what it feels like to be a Husky a little ahead of time. Our counselors will also be available to answer student questions. Masks will be required for students who would like to tour the building. Due to Mead School District's current COVID restrictions, the tour inside will be for students only. After the tour, students can enjoy a shaved ice if they would like and hang around a bit to see their friends. Drop in anytime between 12:30-3:00. Visits should only take 15-25 minutes.

If you are unable to attend, you can pick up your schedule and Chromebook on the following Thursday and Friday, Sept 2nd & 3rd during office hours, 7am-12pm or 1pm-3pm.
